## Transaction Menu: Explanation of Headers




Figure 1: 16 Headers of the Transaction Menu

There are typically 16 headers that the transactions will display in the Transaction Menu.

- **Site:** The number that is assigned to the fuel station by the system
- Tran: The number of the transaction that is assigned by the fuel station
- Card: The last 7 digits of the card
- **Jbr:** The number that is associated with your fuel card issuer
- Acct: The number that is associated with the account a card is under
- Qty: The number of gallons of fuel product that was purchased
- Date: The local day, month, and year of the fuel station that a transaction took place
- **Time:** The local time of the fuel station that a transaction took place
- Auth: 6-digit number that is generated by the fuel station assigned to a unique transaction
- **Pump:** The pump number that is assigned by the fuel station
- **Product:** The product code that is assigned to the fuel product
- Card Input: The way in which the card was read at the pump. "2" means it was swiped and "S" means that it was a cardless transaction.
- Vehicle: The vehicle number that is associated with the vehicle at the time of transaction
- Odometer: The odometer reading that the user entered at the time of transaction
- Misc Entry: A deprecated function.
- **Received:** The year, month, day, hour, minute, and second that the transaction ended, displayed in a YYYYMMDDHHMMSS format
