## Card Information (for Single Card Systems)

- **CFN Card:** the last 7 digits of the card The driver's name or vehicle description printed on the card
- Vehicle ID: the vehicle number assigned to the card
- Customer No: the account number
- Participant No: our jobber number, which is always 344

## Card Information (for Floating PIN Systems)

- **CFN Card:** the 7 digits of the virtual driver number The name of the driver
- Vehicle ID: the vehicle number assigned to the card the name of the vehicle card (physical plastic)
- Customer No: the account number
- Participant No: our jobber number, which is always 344





## Purchase Information

- Site No: the number assigned to the site
- Address 1 Line
- City, State, Zip
- Date/Time: the local date and local time of the station at the time of transaction
- Transaction No: the number assigned to the transaction by the station
- Manual entry: can be ignored as this is a deprecated function
- **Odometer entry:** the odometer reading that the driver entered at the time of transaction

## Product, Quantity, and Description

- **Product:** the product code that was purchased at the time of transaction
- Quantity: the number of gallons purchased
- **Description:** the type of product purchased
